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National Hospital Week Puts Spotlight on People

CARLSBAD, NM – MAY 12, 2010 – – A hospital is more than a place where people go to heal, it is a part of the community that fosters health and represents hope. From providing treatment and comfort to the sick, to welcoming new life into the world, hospitals are central to a healthy and optimistic community. That's the message organizers are touting with the 2010 National Hospital Week theme "Health, Hope & Healing."

The event theme is the centerpiece of a promotional campaign aimed at uniting health care facilities across the country during the May 9–15 celebration.

"National Hospital Week, first and foremost, is a celebration of people," said Lori Elyasevich, Director of Carlsbad Medical Center's Rehabilitation Therapy Services and organizer for CMC's Hospital Week festivities. "We're extremely proud of each member of our staff and we recognize the important role they play in extending a sense of trust to our patients and our community."

The nation's largest health care event, National Hospital Week dates back to 1921 when it was suggested by a magazine editor who hoped a community wide celebration would alleviate public fears about hospitals. The celebration, launched in Chicago, succeeded in promoting trust and goodwill among members of the public and eventually spread to facilities across the country.

Carlsbad Medical Center and Pecos Valley Physician Group employ over 700 people. To show appreciation for all employees, activities this week include a car wash, where hospital directors wash the cars of their employees, and daily drawings for prizes donated by local businesses. The internal theme for CMC's Hospital Week is "Casino Days," with activities and free meals for employees each day associated with a different casino, such as Hard Rock Casino, Caesar's Palace, Treasure Island, Circus Circus, as well as New Mexico casinos.
