Remodeling project nearing completion for CMC's Women's Services Unit

After several months of construction, the remodeling of Carlsbad Medical Center's 2nd floor Women's Services Unit is nearing completion, and will result in modern, family-friendly LDRs (Labor, Deliver, Recovery rooms) for OB patients. The project is part of CMC's \$15 million renovation that began in October of 2009, with the final phase expected to be complete by the end of 2010.

An open house event is being planned for early October. At the open house, the public will be able to tour the unit and view the new rooms, meet physicians and nursing staff, and also learn about CMC's new "Tiny Toes" program. Since 2004, CMC has reinvested a total of \$20 million in improvements and expansions, including a new Outpatient Diagnostic Center, upgraded diagnostic imaging equipment, an expanded Intensive Care Unit, and an upgraded and expanded Emergency Department. A \$15 million renovation project begun in 2009 includes the construction of additional operating rooms, a renovated Women's Services Unit, and a remodeled front entrance and lobby, is scheduled to be completed by December 2010.
